Panelists receive a \$200 honorarium for each day of the meeting. In addition, in-state travel, accommodations, and per diem is offered for those who travel more than 35 miles to NYSCA's Office.

How It Works

Panelists read and review materials in advance, then meet at the NYSCA office in New York City to rate applications according to three main criteria. Ratings along with panel comments are presented to the Council to inform funding decisions.

- Keeps the review process confidential and discloses any potential conflicts of interest (for or against)
